At Jacob Dittoe's request, Father Edward Fenwick arrived in Somerset October 1808 and celebrated **the first Mass in Ohio** in Jacob Dittoe's home. Along with other Catholic families, they founded Saint Joseph parish.

Programs Available

Day Program, Grades 1-5
